Summer Youth Community Service & Environmental Education Program

Project Sponsor Application

Each summer, Project ReGeneration youth teams conduct community service projects with many agency partners in Marin and Sonoma County, providing unique opportunities for youth members and assisting partners in accomplishing their own seasonal objectives.

Project ReGeneration teams may provide sponsoring agencies the following:

- 3-5 hours per day of actual service on project (environmental or social projects)
- Length of project may vary from one day, to repeated visits throughout the eight-week program (however, teams will not serve more than four days in a row on one project)
- Multiple teams may work on the project for several weeks when needed
- Depending on the project type, CCNB can provide some or all of the tools that would be needed for environmental service projects
- Youth teams from sixth-ninth grades , 10 members per team and two team leaders (supervision/discipline by the agency is not required)
- CCNB provides transportation, supervision, meals (individuals bring their own), and worker's compensation insurance.

Agency sponsors would be expected to provide the following for Project ReGeneration teams:

- Introduction to the project and purpose of the project (10-30 minutes)
- Project instructions, methodology, how to use the tools, etc.
- Periodic supervision of project (not Project ReGeneration members)
- All materials or cost for the project (e.g. wood, paint, etc.)
- Suggested: educational talk about the project purpose or the site of the project (e.g. native plant walk, natural history of area, tour)

Examples of possible community service projects:

- recycling related projects
- exotic plant removal
- litter abatement
- painting/building
- food bank/dining hall service
- trail building and maintenance
- stream habitat restoration
- community/school gardening
- field surveys/monitoring projects (population or other)
- leading art projects with younger youth/elderly/disabled
